



How do you think a woman's chance of getting <u>osteoporosis</u> is affected by her taking birth control pills?





How do you think a woman's chance of getting blood clots is affected by her taking birth control pills?



How do you think a woman's chance of getting <u>ovarian cancer</u> is affected by her taking birth control pills?






